### **RESERVING CAMPSITES and TENTS**

It is important that the team which prepares the campsite knows who has booked campsites and whether a tent or caravan is to be located on the site. Each year we tend to have mix-ups and problems in getting the camp site exactly how everyone expects

it. While in general the problems are few, there are sufficient to make it very inconvenient for all concerned. (Not the least for those who are responsible for erecting tents).

In order to try to get the organising of the campsite correct **we attach the 2010 plan of the campsite.** This plan indicates who booked which campsite and whether it was for a caravan or a tent. We request all entrants to indicate their requirements **IF THESE HAVE CHANGED FROM 2010.** If we do not receive an amended campsite plan for 2011 we will assume that your requirements as shown on the 2010 plan are correct and will organise the camp site accordingly.

Please note that each campsite must indicate whether it is to have a caravan or a tent and that the size of tent is clearly shown. If you do not wish to book a campsite in 2011 please indicate on the plan that you no longer require a campsite and address a separate note to this effect to the office.

We require this information in the **SABU Office** by 28th February 2011 at the latest. This cut off date must be adhered to as we need to make our tent requirements known to the army by this date. It also allows us to plan for the number of labourers required to erect tents. Should you miss this deadline, your 2010 campsite requirements will be allocated to you.

Your co-operation in this matter is greatly appreciated.
