*Distances*            800 and 900 metres

*No Of Shots*        Two Sighting shots and ten to count at 800 metres plus two sighting shots and eleven to count at 900 metres

*Prizes*            Gold, Silver and Bronze medals for the first three places in Target Rifle, F Class, 303 and Juniors.

**In two stages**

*Open to*

- (1) International Target Rifle Teams, representing a country, consisting of twelve firers, a captain, an adjutant/manager, a main coach and three sub coaches.*
- (2) Invitation National Teams, representing a country, consisting of eight firers, a captain, an adjutant/manager, a main coach and two sub coaches.*
- (3) Invitation Teams consisting of eight firers, a captain, an adjutant/manager, a main coach and two sub coaches representing States, Provinces, or Clubs.*
- (4) Invitation 303 Rifle Teams consisting of four firers, a captain and a coach from Countries, States, Provinces or Clubs*
- (5) Junior International Target Rifle Teams consisting of six firers, a captain and two coaches.*
- (6) Under 25 International Target Rifle Teams consisting of six firers, a captain and two coaches*
- (7) Invitation F Class Int. Teams consisting of six firers, a captain, and two coaches from States, Provinces or Clubs.*
