2009 SA TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP ENTRIES

The SA Team Championships is divided into two competitions – a closed championship competed for by all South African clubs and an open competition in which overseas teams are invited to participate. South African clubs entering the SA Team Championships are automatically entered into both championships.

There is a limited number of targets and teams will be accommodated on a first come first served basis. Entry forms for all club and provincial matches are available on SABU's website.

SELECTION OF TEAM FOR PALMA 2011

1. Selection of Squad:

It has been decided by the Selection Committee that a squad of approximately 30 shooters (including shooters, coaches and co-coordinators) will be nominated in May 2009.

The basis of selection for this squad will be mainly on:

Scores (both team and individual) attained at the 2008 and 2009 SA Open Championships.

- Individual Scores – Thomas Theron
- Team Scores – Club Championships, Interprovincial matches, National- and International matches.

2. Selection of Team:

The squad will also participate in a number of training sessions after the 2009 SA's.

The Scores attained at the 2009 and 2010 SA Open Championships (both team and individual matches) plus the results of the training sessions will be used to select the SA Palma Team.

3. Please take note that the Selection Committee reserved the right to add shooter to the squad and/or withdraw shooter from the squad and final team.
